

SAY Plus can provide new options and opportunities for our players and provide another aspect of our program to be marketed to new areas is something that must be done for the benefit of all.

An approved SAY Plus- SAY area may combine teams to form leagues with another SAY area or SAY areas.

It is SAY mandate that all players shall be allowed to play at least one-half of every game (in total time played) or as close to that amount of time as possible.

Children under 8 years of age may not play on a SAY Plus team.

Players who wish to join a SAY Plus team must be either “invited” or specially selected to participate in the SAY Plus Program.

Teams may only be broken down into one or two year age groups.

We will be able to nurture all of the players and help them become more talented and refined.

The SAY Plus Program is not mandatory and therefore, areas and districts do not have to take part should they choose not to.

All coaches must have at least three full seasons of dedicated head coaching experience to be eligible to coach a SAY Plus team.

SAY Plus teams may play with other USSF affiliated leagues.

A “supplementary” SAY Plus Program could be played entirely within a SAY area’s “secondary” season so players could participate in both seasons.

SAY Plus matches move at a much faster pace than regular matches. Therefore, the area should strive to assign only experienced referees to these matches. Referees who are equipped to handle “heated competition” should be considered for this type of referee assignment.

SAY Plus is a complimentary program where the “SAY Plus” teams are made up of players from the primary SAY teams playing and practicing at different times.

Short-sided team format may be used for all age divisions.

The SAY Plus Program is an independent program, where SAY Plus teams and leagues are formed separately and in addition to the primary SAY teams and leagues.
